This funding will be used to achieve:

- 90% of students in Years 1 6 to achieve a 'C' or above by the end of 2018 or have an evidence based learning plan in place to address point of need for individual students
- 85% of Year 5 students to achieve Band 3 or above in Writing 2018 NAPLAN
- 60% of Year 3 students to achieve Band 3 or above in Writing 2018 NAPLAN
- Year 3 students in 2019 to achieve Band 3 or above in reading and writing meeting or exceeding National Minimum Standard (NMS) in NAPLAN 2019.

Our initiatives include:

- further developing the quality of teacher and teacher aide feedback to students
- providing focused individual or small group teaching to extend student to the Upper Two Bands in NAPLAN or achieve an 'A' standard
- providing focused individual teaching to students working at a 'D' or 'C' level to reach the 'C' or 'B' level of achievement
- ensuring alignment of A–E data and NAPLAN data for Years 3 and 5
- teachers to establish individual student goals to assist all students to achieve at an 'A' or 'B' level of achievement
- staff reviewing data collection processes to ensure effective teaching and learning practices are data driven and effective
- revisiting and consolidating staff capacity to deliver instruction explicitly through profession development and staff interactions.
